


- A good first course to find is D01(A)-Buddhism for Beginners, The Supreme and Magnificent Dharma

Lesson Previews




 Sometimes a lesson on the *Curriculum* tab will have a *Preview* button that allows you to try out the lesson without enrolling in the course



What is Prerequisite courses

- Many courses have *Prerequisites*
 courses you must complete
 before you can begin the course
 you're looking at
- Click on the *Prerequisites* button and it will open a drop-down list of the required courses
- Clicking on any of these courses will take you directly to the Home Page for that course where you can enroll in it

- You can also return to the course at any time and view your certificate of completion




- When you have completed all the Prerequisites for a course, the gold *Prerequisites* button is gone and you now have a green *Get Course* option
- You are now ready to *Enroll* in your chosen course

Enrolling in a Course



- A good first course to enroll in is D01(A)-Buddhism for Beginners, The Supreme and Magnificent Dharma
- It has no prerequisites but is a prerequisite for many other courses

Enrollment Step 1



- Click on *Get Course* to open the drop-down
- Click on Enroll with Membership

Enrollment Step 2



- A pop-up window appears telling you what your current *Membership Plan* is
- Click on *Enroll with Membership* to continue
- It takes a little while to process the enrollment. Don't click again

Enrollment Step 3



- When the enrollment is complete you are returned to the course Home Page
- The green *Get Course* button is replaced with a maroon *Start Course* button
